#### OUTSTANDING ALUMNI AWARD

#### Dr. Nicholas J. Pratt, RN Associate of Applied Science in Nursing - 2014



Nicholas Pratt, MD, RN has represented himself as an alumnus of Rhodes State College on both the national and international level. He is one of the nation's few graduates of nursing school and medical school. He is currently a resident physician at one of the nation's top psychiatric residency training programs at Yale University. He has authored several peer-reviewed publications on important topics like the impact of artificial intelligence and social media. Additionally, he has contributed to the arts through photography and was named a three-time Featured Artist in art shows in New

York City and Connecticut.

In 2014, Dr. Pratt earned his Associate of Science in Nursing degree from Rhodes State College and went on to attain two bachelor's degrees, one in Nursing from The Ohio State University, and the other in Health Science from Cleveland State University. In 2022, he earned his Doctor of Medicine degree from Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) and went on to his residency at the Yale University School of Medicine Department of Psychiatry in New Haven, Connecticut.

He began his career in the medical field as a Patient Care Technician in the Cardiac Intervention Unit at Lima Memorial Health System in 2013. He moved on to Blanchard Valley Health System as a Registered Staff Nurse and, then, to the Vascular Institute as a Critical Care Nursing Intern. He returned to Lima Memorial Health System in 2015 as a Registered Nurse in Critical Care, and from there went on to medical school.

Dr. Pratt currently serves as a member of the American Psychiatric Association and Alpha Omega Alpha. At Rhodes State, he has returned to encourage and instruct students as well as serve as the featured speaker at the 2017 Scholarship Awards Reception.

"My time at Rhodes State College has tremendously impacted my personal and professional life," said Pratt. "I would characterize it as my most impactful academic experience. It provided me with real-world experience, ignited my passion for the healing arts, and kick-started my career. My journey at Rhodes enriched me with invaluable mentorship and a community that championed my ambitions. Rhodes State College provides our community with transformative impacts. I am proud to have represented Rhodes State on both the national and, now, international scale. I look forward to continuing to do so."

#### COMMENCEMENT

#### ACADEMIC PROCESSIONAL

The academic processional which officially preludes the graduation ceremonies on college and university campuses is an old and colorful custom which links 21st century education with its early origins.

To recognize the achievements of their students, American institutions of higher learning conduct a formal ceremony to award the appropriate degrees earned at the conclusion of prescribed study. The action of taking the degree—associate, bachelor, masters, or doctors—as well as the designation of the day itself—is Commencement. It may be in May or at the end of other formal periods of study, as the faculty may designate. Various explanations of the term Commencement are possible. The most likely is that centuries ago the bachelor, originally an apprentice, began his apprenticeship upon that day; and with the degree of M.A. and Ph.D—the masters and the doctors commenced their work upon the day their degrees were conferred. So today, the student having finished the required preliminary training sets out upon the new career.

#### ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic regalia worn at Commencement is of medieval origin. The scholars of Bologna, Salamanca, Paris, Oxford, Cambridge, Louvain and Heidelberg dressed in a manner to distinguish themselves from the merchants and other townspeople. Since the 11th century, when the rise of the universities began, "learned clerks" robed themselves in gowns, caps and hoods, thus marking a difference between "town and gown."

By this apparel, they were recognized as belonging to the teaching guild, which was the Guild of the Masters of Arts. The gown, in origin, may have been simply a type of overcoat to protect the teacher from the cold in the unheated buildings; the cut or style seems to be derived from ecclesiastical attire. The cap or "mortarboard" may have come from the squarish cap worn by the masons of the Middle Ages, or perhaps was suggested by the shape of the books which occupied so much of the time of the scholar. The hood, a triangular fold of cloth worn over the back of the gown, is faced with colors which denote the field of study represented by the wearer's degree; the colors of the lining are those of the college or university from which the degree was granted. Members of the governing body of a college or university, whatever their degrees, may wear doctor's gowns.

A good deal of variation characterizes the order of the academic processional or march. Commonly the Marshall leads the procession and directs its course. The Marshall is followed by the faculty in order of rank: professors; associate professors: assistant professors: instructors: recipients of honorary degrees and others to be honored; and, the President and Trustees of the institution accompanying the chief speaker.

#### CEREMONIAL MACE

The Mace, which dates back to medieval time when it was used as a weapon, has become a symbol of authority. Traditionally, colleges or universities design their mace to symbolize a theme or message that is central to their mission. The mace is carried in all formal academic processions in which the institution's president participates.

The central motif of the College seal reflects the geographical shape of Ohio, signifying state ownership. The torch, which is placed in the center of the seal, is symbolic of the light of knowledge and wisdom. The bronze enameled piece sets on top of a fluted cherry wood staff with engravable bronze rings. The institution's core values: Integrity, Caring, Responsibility, Respect and Quality are engraved in the mace's bronze head piece.

#### PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

The medallion is a symbol of the Office of the President. It is suspended on a bronze chain which incorporates the names of the College's past presidents in its links. When the current president's term ends, her name will be inscribed on the unbroken chain of Rhodes State College's former presidents. The President's Medallion central motif reflects the geographical shape of Ohio, signifying state ownership. The torch, which is placed in the center of the seal, is symbolic of the light of knowledge and wisdom.

**Tau Upsilon Alpha** is a National Human Services Honorary Society symbolized by a medallion on a gold and royal blue ribbon.
