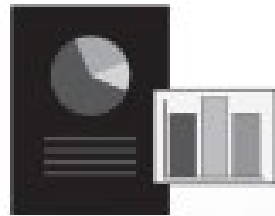


What is Changing Campus Culture?

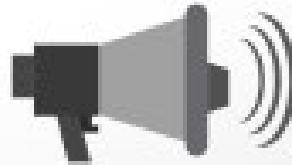

Five Cornerstone Strategies



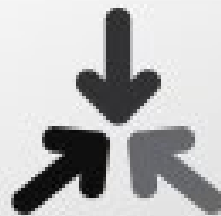
