Rhodes State Signs Articulation Agreement with University of Illinois

LIMA, OH – Today, Rhodes State College signed a formal articulation agreement with The University of Illinois Springfield (UIS) allowing Rhodes State Networking graduates the opportunity to complete their Bachelor's in Computer Science without leaving Lima. UIS has agreed to take all of the credits from Rhodes State College's Information Technology Networking degree toward the first two years of the UIS bachelor's degree.

Rhodes State students will be able to complete the rest of their bachelor's degree by taking a combination of Rhodes State courses and online courses from UIS. UIS is allowing students to take multiple networking courses at Rhodes State College that will count as third and fourth year courses in the UIS bachelor's degree curriculum.

“Rhodes State has demonstrated a commitment to making higher education accessible, which is a principle our college was founded on. This is a fabulous opportunity for Rhodes State College students and the fact that UIS recognizes several of our networking courses as being equivalent to third and fourth year bachelor degree level courses speaks to the outstanding quality of our Information Technology programs,” said Kathy Simindinger, Chair, Information Technology Program at Rhodes State College.

To date, Rhodes State College maintains over 50 articulation agreements representing 16 colleges.
