Rhodes State is pleased to offer courses to qualified students interested in participating in the *Post Secondary Enrollment Options Program*. This program is designed to allow Ohio high school students the opportunity to earn college credit while still in high school. To participate in this program at Rhodes, a student must:

- secure the permission of his/her parents or legal guardian and a high school official;
- meet the admissions requirements (as designated for the area of interest); and

Please read and consider the following enrollment opportunities carefully:

Traditional Post Secondary Enrollment Options

This option is available to students (ninth-twelfth grades) who have demonstrated the academic ability and potential to do college-level work. Students must have the following requirements to enter PSEOP at Rhodes State: Seniors and juniors must have a 3.0 GPA *or* 22 ACT, *or* be ranked in the top 25% of his/her class; sophomores must have a 3.5 GPA and a 22 ACT, and be ranked in the top 25% of his/her class. Freshmen must have a 3.75 GPA from 7th and 8th grade course work and a 22 ACT, and be ranked in the top 25% of students in the 8th grade. Admitted students may register for courses after conferring with the Rhodes State academic advisor.

Please note: In compliance with Amended Substitute House Bill 282, a student may not enroll in any specific college course through PSEOP if the student has taken high school courses in the same subject area as that college course and has failed to attain a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent, in such completed high school courses.

Rhodes State College Special Initiative PSEOP

These course options are available to students (typically, eleventh or twelfth grade only) who have an interest in technical courses. Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 and submit a letter of recommendation from a high school counselor or faculty member. Options are limited to specific technical courses. Admitted students will register for courses after meeting with a Rhodes State academic advisor.
