



# The 2011-2012 Emergency Loan Fund Application

Rhodes State College offers one-time, short-term, non-interest bearing emergency loans up to \$500 to students who otherwise would not be able to continue enrollment because of a short-term financial crisis. The payback of the emergency loan money will be taken out of your excess grants and loans before disbursed. Students who are not receiving financial aid must make payment arrangements in the Business Office to pay the balance in full within one year. Emergency loan funds are limited, so the loans will be distributed on a “first-come/first-served” basis. To be eligible for a short-term emergency loan, students must:

1. Have experienced an unexpected emergency that has affected their temporary cash flow to the extent that they cannot remain enrolled.
2. Write a letter explaining the unexpected emergency and attach supporting documentation.
3. Applied for federal financial aid (FAFSA)
4. Be enrolled for at least 6 credit hours for the current quarter or previous quarter not including summer quarter.
5. Have a reasonable expectation of academic success- 2.0 GPA for current students; evidence of academic success from new students (transcript).
6. Be in good standing with the College
7. Be receiving specific and adequate resources (i.e., anticipated financial aid).

Students will not be eligible for emergency loans if:

1. They have a current outstanding balance from a previous term
2. They are in default for their student loans or are in collection from the college

**Please note:** Tuition, fees, and book charges are normal and not considered an unexpected emergency.
