Important Advising, Registration and Fee Payment Dates

October 14	ON-TIME Registration for Continuing PSEOP (Post Secondary Enrollment Option Program) Student Registration Begins
October 17	ON-TIME Registration for all Continuing Allied Health and Nursing Students Registration Begins (General Prep Health Registration Begins October 24)
October 24	ON-TIME Registration begins for All Other Continuing Students and Reactivating Students
December 14	FEES due—registrations canceled after 5 p.m. for Non-Payment. Registration shuts down at 5 p.m. for processing. Fees must be received by the Business Office by 5 p.m. Envelopes postmarked on this date will be considered late and subject to a \$50 Late Registration Fee. Registration (including Web) is not available until 12:00 p.m. on December 15).
Dec 15-Jan 2	LATE Registration begins. Registration returns to service at 12:00p.m. for new registrations and drop add. All current students completing their initial registration or re-registering after non-payment of fees will be assessed a \$50 Late Registration fee. Payment arrangements need to be made by 5:00 p.m. on January 17 or the registration will be canceled.
Dec 24-Jan 2	All College offices will be closed. Offices will re-open on Tuesday, January 3 from 8am-5pm. The bookstore will be open Wednesday, December 28 through Friday, December 30 from 8am-5pm.
January 3	Winter Quarter Classes Begin (10-week and first 5-week)
January 3-9	Students may add a class that has not met or add a class that has met with Dean's Approval. One-Third minimum tuition payment and \$25 installment payment plan fee must be paid to secure registration.
January 5	Last day for 100% refund for first 5-week classes
January 9	Last day for 100% refund for 10-week classes Last day for 50% refund for first 5-week classes
January 17	Last day for 50% refund for 10-week classes Graduation Petitions are due for Spring graduation
January 25	Last day to drop/withdraw without a petition for first 5-week classes
February 2-3	Finals - First 5 week classes
February 6	Second 5-week classes begin
February 8	Last day for 100% refund for second 5-week classes
February 10	Last day to make up Fall 2011 incompletes
February 13	Last day for 50% refund for second 5-week classes
February 17	Last day to drop/withdraw without a petition 10-week classes
February 29	Last day to drop/withdraw without a petition second 5-week classes
March 12	Last day of regularly scheduled classes - second 5-week and 10-week terms
March 13-19	Finals week for Winter
