Rhodes State College's One Night a Week Business Administration Program Accepting Students

LIMA, Ohio – The One Night a Week Business Administration program at Rhodes State College is accepting students. This program provides working adults the opportunity to earn an associate degree while attending classes only one night a week. The next cohort begins January 30, 2013 and will be held on Wednesday evenings.

The One Night a Week Program allows working adult students to stay on the leading edge of the job market and helps them complete a Business Administration associate degree beneficial to career advancement. Working adult students pursuing this Business Administration degree develop competencies in management, marketing, interpersonal relations and team building, financial management, information systems, and other areas.

The One Night a Week program is with a group or cohort of peers. Classes meet only one night a week for a four-hour session making it easier for working adults to balance school, work and family responsibilities. The course sequence flows seamlessly and often focuses on one course at a time. This degree option has special admissions criteria.
