No pre-requisite to attend

This introductory course takes a beginner's look at GIS and how it can be applied to a variety of professions, as well as home and leisure initiatives. Explore what GIS is, what you can do with it and how it's currently being used.

#L3981A— Introducing GIS to Your Business
Fridays, February 3, 10, 17 and 24, 2012; 8:00am to 1:00pm
Pre-requisite: *The Basics of GIS*

This course covers underlying geographic concepts (world coordinate system and projections, vector map topology, tiled and layered maps); map design and outputs; geodatabases; importing spatial and attribute data; digitizing; geocoding; and spatial data processing and analysis. The technical focus of the course includes computer lab tutorials and case studies using the leading desktop GIS software.

#L3982A— Applying GIS Data to Your Business
Thursdays, March 1, 8, 15 and 22, 2012; 8:00am to 1:00pm
Pre-requisite: *Introducing GIS to Your Business*

The basics course answered "What is GIS?" This course explores "Why use GIS?" You will learn to use a problem-solving tool from first stages of designing an analysis project through the data collection and manipulation phase to the final phase of presenting the project. Emphasis will be placed on making the final project thorough and presented in a good manner.
