



- Compass Placement Testing is required for new students. Your test scores will assist your academic advisor through the course scheduling process. *Call 419-995-8476 to schedule your testing.*
- When you receive your New Student Orientation information please follow the directions provided to RSVP for one of the dates right away. You will meet your academic advisor and register for courses at orientation.
- Have your transcripts sent to us from your high school and any former college or university. Passed your GED? Just send us a copy of your score report.
- The ACT is required for our Allied Health and Nursing students. If you took it in high school, your scores will probably be on your transcript. If you have not taken it, don't worry, we offer on campus for our students through the Testing Center.
- The FAFSA. This one is worth mentioning again. We encourage all students to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid. You can do this online and it is required for state and federal student aid, many scholarships, and the Federal Work-Study Program.
