

# Become a Medical Lab Technician



Medical Laboratory Technicians are a critical part of any health care team, serving as the "detective" turning clues into useful diagnostic statements. Medical Laboratory Technicians may work in several areas of the clinical laboratory, or just specialize in one field.

Through the Northwest Ohio Allied Health Education Consortium, students can now attend Rhodes State College for all general education course work and enroll in Marion Technical College's Medical Laboratory Technology program. Students take courses through a blended format of distance education and live laboratory sessions at Marion with only one trip to Marion a week with the newly announced Saturday only laboratory session. Local clinical experiences will be arranged during the last quarter in the program so that you receive your clinical experience in a laboratory near your home. After successful completion of all coursework, students will receive the degree from Marion Technical College. Significant grants are available for qualifying students to assist with tuition, books, and fees.

Graduates will be eligible to take certification examinations by the American Society of Clinical Pathologists and the National Credentialing Agency for Laboratory Personnel.
