

Many scholarships are available through the Rhodes State College Foundation and through external sources for students. Most applications for scholarships are available January 2012 and provide funding for the upcoming academic year. Students can apply for foundation scholarships online at www.rhodesstate.edu/scholarships. **All scholarships administered have minimum standards for the student to receive funding and require a personal statement and two letters of recommendation.** A recommendation form is available online at www.rhodesstate.edu/scholarships. Most awards are divided into equal parts over two academic semesters (Fall and Spring) unless specified differently at the time of the award. Each semester's award is dependent on the academic success of the student during the prior semester and is subject to the Scholarship Program Standards. **All applicants must submit a FAFSA, available online at www.FAFSA.gov, to be eligible for scholarships.** Please see the requirements listed below for Foundation scholarships. Other criteria may apply.

Scholarship	Eligibility Requirements
Division of Allied Health	
Anonymous Scholarship	Full-time students majoring in Occupational Therapy Assistant and demonstrating financial need as defined by the Rhodes State College Financial Aid Office. Preference is given to single parents and veterans. A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required.
Anigbogu Godwin Rovner Respiratory Care Scholarship	Current or incoming students who are enrolled in the Respiratory Care Major may apply. Students must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA or above and demonstrate financial need.
Borra Family Foundation Scholarship	Full-time students who have and must maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA and who have demonstrated financial need.
Dr. Robert D. Brunk Scholarship	Students with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA who must answer an essay question regarding dental hygiene practice and complete a brief biographical sketch of the applicant. A personal interview may also be required.
Elizabeth Enneking Memorial Scholarship	Full-time students who have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and have completed or are completing their first year of study in NSG, RES, OTA, PTA or ECE program. Must have at least one recommendation from a clinical site supervisor or faculty member and an interest in working with young children with special needs.
Frank and Shirley Hill Scholarship	First year, full-time students who have and are able to maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.
Terri Hill-Kaufman Memorial Scholarship	Students who have successfully completed at least 12 credit hours with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and who have the ability to be a successful student at Rhodes State College.
Respiratory Care Alumni Scholarship	Full or part-time students who have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and who are completing the first year of the Respiratory Care Program.
Thomas R. and Gloria P. Leech Scholarship	Students enrolled in a Health major who demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA, which must be maintained. Preference is given to residents of Allen and Hardin counties.
Thomas and Linda Leshner Dental Hygiene Scholarship	Full-time students who have successfully completed at least 12 credit hours with a minimum 3.3 cumulative GPA; must be qualified and accepted into the Dental Hygiene program for Fall 2012 clinicals.
Waldren Family Scholarship	Awarded to an Allied Health or Nursing major with demonstrated financial need. Preference given to a single parent or child of single parent & if all other criteria are equal, to a first generation student.

Dr. Nancy P. Redding Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a student in the Arts & Sciences Division with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and a demonstrated financial need.
Division of Nursing	
Avis Hardin Smith Memorial Scholarship	Students enrolled in the Nursing program at Rhodes State College. Preference is given to graduates of Perry or Waynesfield-Goshen school district, then to Allen, Auglaize, or Hardin county residents. A 2.0 cumulative GPA is required.

Elizabeth Enneking Memorial Scholarship	Full-time students who have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and have completed or are completing their first year of study in the NSG, RES, OTA, PTA or ECE program. Must have at least one recommendation from a clinical site supervisor or faculty member and an interest in working with young children with special needs.
Terri Hill-Kaufman Memorial Scholarship	Students who have successfully completed at least 12 credit hours with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and have the ability to be a success at Rhodes State College.
Thomas R. and Gloria P. Leech Scholarship	Students who are enrolled in a Health major who demonstrate financial need and have and maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to residents of Allen and Hardin counties.
Nursing Scholarship	Second-year Nursing students who have and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA and demonstrate financial need.
John and Margie Robenalt Memorial Scholarship	Nursing students who have completed one year of training in the program with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. Two recommendations from members of the Nursing faculty are required.
Waldren Family Scholarship	Awarded to an Allied Health or Nursing major with demonstrated financial need. Preference given to a single parent or child of single parent & if all other criteria equal, to a first generation student.
Division of Business and Public Service	
Elizabeth Enneking Memorial Scholarship	Full-time students who have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and have completed or are completing their first year of study in the NSG, RES, OTA, PTA or ECE program. Must have at least one recommendation from a clinical site supervisor or faculty member and an interest in working with young children with special needs.
John and Irene Kinkley Scholarship	Mechanical Engineering or Education Technology major, resident of Auglaize or Mercer County, minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA, and one of several children in family attending college at time of application.
Gary Weaver Public Service Scholarship	Full-time students enrolled in ECE, HUM, or LAW who have completed or are completing 30 credit hours toward his/her major and have verified financial need. A recommendation from the Chair of his/her department is required. A 2.0 cumulative GPA is required.
John J. and Martha M. Hudson Scholarship	Full-time students who live in Allen County and are majoring in a Business program or a program in the Division of Information Technology and Engineering Technology at Rhodes State College. Students are required to have a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
Margot and Robert B. Keller Public Service Scholarship	Any full-time student majoring in ECE, HUM, or LAW who have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. A recommendation from a faculty member of his/her department or a high school advisor is required.
One Night a Week Champion Scholarship	Enrolled in Business Administration One Night a Week major, has minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and 30 credit hours completed; seeks career advancement; possesses ability to balance family, employment and education; self-motivated; and community minded.
Rudy and Norma Rakowsky Scholarship	Full-time students with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA. Students must be majoring in Engineering Technologies or Business.
Division of Information Technology and Engineering Technology	
Hardin County Engineering Technology Scholarship	Full-time Engineering Technology students who demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to students of Hardin County.
John J. and Martha M. Hudson	Full-time students in Allen County majoring in a Business program or a program in the Division of Information Technology and Engineering Technology. A 2.0 cumulative GPA is required.
John and Irene Kinkley Scholarship	Mechanical Engineering or Education Technology major, resident of Auglaize or Mercer County, minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA, and one of several children in family attending college at time of application.

Scholarships	Eligibility Requirements
Marilyn Shaffer Office Administration Scholarship	Full or part-time students majoring in Office Administration who have completed at least 25 credit hours with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. A recommendation from an Office Administration faculty member is required.
Rudy and Norma Rakowsky Scholarship	Full-time students majoring in Engineering Technologies or Business with at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
Roger P. Jones Concrete Technology Scholarship	Full or part-time students registered in Civil Engineering in the Concrete Technologies program with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.
West Central Ohio Manufacturing Consortium Scholarship	Full and part-time students interested in obtaining an intermediate or advanced certification in manufacturing career pathways and/or a degree in Engineering Technology/Information Technology or a related field. Must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.
All Divisions/Majors	
Norman and Margaret Browning Scholarship	Students who demonstrate unmet financial need and have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to students of Allen County.
James J. Countryman Scholarship	Any full-time student who has demonstrated financial need and does not qualify for other forms of financial aid. Student must maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
Distance Education Scholarship	Full or part-time students who have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA and work at least 20 hours per week. The students must have or be in the process of completing 30 credit hours with 25% of those hours being in a distance education format.
Dr. Wilfred Ellis Multicultural Scholarship	Students of multicultural backgrounds who demonstrate financial need and maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to Allen County residents.
Faculty and Staff Student Scholarship	Any full-time student with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA who has demonstrated financial need as defined by the Rhodes State Financial Aid Office.
Gilbert Scholarship	Any full or part-time student, age 21 years or older, demonstrating financial need and are self supporting as defined by the Rhodes State College Financial Aid Office. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is also required.
Jack and Margaret Howell Putnam County Scholarship	Full-time students who must maintain at least a 2.9 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to residents and high school graduates of Putnam County.
Lima Elks Fifty Four Athletic & Scholastic Fund	Any full or part-time student with a demonstrated financial need and a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA is eligible to apply.
McClain/Marshall Scholarship	Female students age 30 or over who demonstrate financial need with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to graduates of Ada High School then to residents of Hardin County.
Kito Christian Shane McCurdy Scholarship	Any full or part-time student who demonstrates financial need with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to an Allen County resident who is a first-time student at Rhodes State College, including PSEOP.
Memorial Scholarship	Any full or part-time student who has earned at least 24 credit hours at Rhodes State College. A minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA is required.
Outstanding Alumni Scholarship	Full or part-time students who have demonstrated financial need. Must maintain at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA in his/her program of study and be enrolled in the same program as the prior year's Outstanding Alumni award recipient (2011 awarded to Nursing alum).
George B. Quatman Scholarship	Any full-time student with a minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA and an ACT score of 22.
Rhodes State Scholarship	Any student with a minimum 2.5 GPA and demonstrated financial need.
David and Marie Steiner Scholarship	Full-time students with unmet financial need who have a 3.0 cumulative GPA in his/her program of study. Preference is given to students of Allen County.
Matthew C. Terrill Memorial Scholarship	Students who have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to graduates of Ridgemont High School, then to residents of Hardin or Logan counties.
