Associate of Arts & Associate of Science Degrees

Rhodes State College is a great place to start your education especially for those wanting to transfer on to attain a bachelor's degree. Earning credits through Rhodes State is affordable as our tuition is \$92.30 per credit hour.

Rhodes State is now offering the Associate of Arts (AA) and Associate of Science (AS) Degrees--these degrees easily transfer to a university for two years of credit toward a bachelor's degree. The credits earned in an AA or AS will be transferable to a public university in the University System of Ohio and to various private institutions.

If students entering the AA or AS program choose to transfer prior to completing the associate degree, they will be able to do so with their AA/AS credits transferring. The exact mix of courses required at the university level to earn a bachelor's degree will depend on what major the student selects. Because transfer institutions may require specific courses to transfer into individual programs, students should customize their course selection as closely as possible to the requirements at the four-year institution of their choice. Students have the responsibility to work closely with their advisors to stay informed of changes and revisions in curriculum.

Associate of Arts Degree

The Associate of Arts degree is for the student who intends to transfer to a four-year college or university and wants an education with a liberal arts emphasis. The Associate of Arts degree prepares graduates for further study in any of the following areas: communication, English, history, psychology, sociology, pre-law and others. The Associate of Arts degree requires successful completion of a minimum of 90 approved quarter credit hours.

Associate of Science Degree

The Associate of Science degree is designed for students who plan to transfer and complete a Bachelor of Science degree. Depending on the electives chosen, the AS prepares for further study in any of the following areas: business, biology, chemistry, physics, engineering, information technology, criminal justice, mathematics, pre-education, pre-medicine, and other fields. Most coursework is in specified mathematics and sciences requirements, but also includes humanities, social sciences and composition/literature. The Associate of Science degree requires successful completion of a minimum of 90 approved quarter credit hours.

Course Selection

Since students should customize their course selection as closely as possible to the requirements at the four-year institution of their choice, they have the responsibility to stay informed of changes in curriculum. See Admissions for details.
