NOTES:

1. The above costs are subject to change.
2. The above has been based on current tuition for student completing the program in two academic years.
3. Student Health Insurance is required for many Fieldwork Sites and should be purchased by student for coverage from 3rd semester first year through graduation.
4. Transportation - student will need transportation to Fieldwork Sites up to 1 hour from home; 1 day /week semesters 3,4 and 5 days/week semester 5.
5. Medical Requirements - physical examination, laboratory tests, and immunization record must be completed before 3rd semester of the first year. This may pose an additional cost if the student does not have all childhood immunizations or needs titre to verify.
6. Room and Board - Students may need to be prepared to meet costs of at least 1 distant fieldwork site for an 8 week period in last semester of second year.

Upon completion of all coursework the student will be required to take a National Certification Exam and receive State Licensure to be able to practice.
