#### - PEACE OFFICER SCHOLARSHIP -

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- Applicant must be a resident of Hardin County.
- O Applicant must be enrolled in a law enforcement program approved by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission.
- The applicant will be interviewed by the VIPS scholarship committee.
- Scholarship funds will be paid to the student's law enforcement academy/program upon receipt of proof of enrollment and/or billing statement.
- o The scholarship committee shall have sole discretion in the selection of the scholarship recipient(s).
- A scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to the successful applicant.
- Applications for the scholarship will be made available to all Hardin County High Schools and Hardin County Law Enforcement Agencies.
- o The availability of scholarship applications and the subsequent award will be published through the Kenton Times, WKTN radio and the Hardin County Sheriff's Office Facebook page.
- O Copies of the application form may be copied and distributed as needed.
