IGNITE

1. How do you ignite student motivation in the classroom, especially in areas which are traditionally considered to be difficult or less than exciting?
2. What tools (e.g., artificial intelligence) and other technologies are you using in the classroom to engage students from various generations in active learning and participation?

LAUNCH

1. How have new academic programs or initiatives impacted student learning at your institution?
2. What student support service initiatives have helped students to be more successful, both on and off campus?

SOAR

1. How do you help students to soar into their respective fields? (Note: collaborations with student presenters are welcome)

Please include the following information in your proposal:

1. Name of lead presenter, e-mail address, phone number, discipline, and institution.
2. Names of co-presenter(s), e-mail address(es), phone number(s), discipline(s), and institution(s).
3. Presentation method (audience interaction recommended for all methods, and student presenters are welcomed and encouraged):
 - a. Presentation: 1-4 presenters presenting on a focused topic
 - b. Panel: 3-5 presenters discussing an area of inquiry related to the conference theme, in conjunction with the audience.
 - c. Poster Session
4. Presentation title
5. A 100-word description that connects presentation content to the mission/conference theme, including a description of how the presentation will be interactive.
6. A one-sentence summary of the primary purpose of the presentation.

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
