REPETITION OF COURSES:

Students may repeat courses taken by audit or credit at James A. Rhodes State College. Each course and each grade earned by the student will be indicated in the student's permanent record, but only the higher grade earned in a course or its first repetition will be used in determining the student's cumulative grade point average. All subsequent repetitions will be used in the cumulative average and must be approved at the time of registrations. (Prior to 1991, a course being taken for the third or subsequent time had a digit added to the course number to differentiate it).
