

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS PROGRAM AT RHODES STATE COLLEGE

Admissions Standards, Eligibility Requirements and Application Checklist

The goal of College Credit Plus (CCP) is to enhance college and career readiness for Ohio students in grades 7 -12. CCP allows students to earn college credit while enrolled in junior high or high school, fulfilling both college and high school graduation requirements.

To participate, a student must:

- ☐ Secure the permission of his/her parents or legal guardian and a high school official
- ☐ Complete and submit the required materials:
 - Rhodes State College Credit Plus Admissions Application
 - Free on-line application www.RhodesState.edu
 - Submission Deadlines – Summer - May 1, Fall – August 1, Spring – December 1
 - Official High School Transcript with standardized test results
- ☐ Private and Homeschooled students will apply for funding by establishing an OH||ID account

Criteria for Student Eligibility (only one criteria must be met):

- ☐ Meet the college readiness standards. The indicators below are assessment thresholds to guarantee “remediation free” status by the Ohio Department of Education. To schedule an Accuplacer (Rhodes Placement Test), call the Testing Center at 419-995-8476. Accuplacer testing may be offered at your high school site. Ask your High School Counselor for further information on testing dates

KEY CCP STEPS

1. Attend your High School's CCP Information Night.

Information Nights are held between October and February. For more information on when and where these will be held, please contact your high school counselor.

2. Submit Letter of Intent:

Public school students must submit the "Intent to Participate" form to the HS Guidance Office. Non-public or Homeschooled students submit letters to the Ohio Department of Higher Education. The deadline for submission is April 1st for Summer and Fall terms or November 1st for Spring term of the year before enrolling in CCP courses.

3. Apply to Rhodes State College:

After you submit your application, you will receive an acceptance letter and an orientation letter with your Rhodes State College ID number (R#) and Rhodes account information.

4. Submit Test Scores/Placement Testing:

Ask your School Counselor to send your High School transcripts with ACT/SAT scores to Rhodes State College and arrange to take placement tests.

5. Orientation:

Complete online or in-person CCP Orientation.

6. Register for Classes:

Schedule your CCP classes with your High School Counselor or your Rhodes State College Credit Plus Pathway Advisor.
