



My name is Matt Kinkley, and I am an Associate Professor in the Addiction, Mental Health, and Social Work Assistant Program. I have over 30 years of experience as a Licensed Social Worker and a Licensed Independent Chemical Dependency Counselor. I teach a wide range of first- and second year courses. From 2018–2025, I served as a Behavioral Therapist at Foundations in Celina, Ohio, where I focused on working with inmates at the Mercer County Jail, delivering Employee Assistance counseling/programming to area businesses, and providing individual therapy to clients with severe mental illness and alcohol and other drug issues. Prior to this, from 2016–2018, I directed the Workforce Development Board for Auglaize, Hardin, Mercer, and Van Wert Counties, as well as a Work-Based Learning Grant in Putnam County. I retired from Rhodes State in 2016 after 25 years in a variety of roles, including the first ten years as Chairperson/Associate Professor of the then Human Services Program. My career at Rhodes also included administrative leadership positions such as Dean, Associate Vice President/Interim Vice President of Academic Affairs, and Executive Director for Workforce Development, during which I served seven years on the College's leadership team. Earlier in my career, I worked as a Chemical Dependency Counselor, directed an AOD agency, served as a Parole Officer, and worked in an adolescent group home.
