

Rhodes State has taken action to meet student need in ways that go beyond academics that can impact health, wellness, and family dynamics. Below, you will find packages that will aid in meeting food, hygiene, and emergency needs of students.

Choose your gift package

A Semester for The SHOP Package \$1,200

It's hard to study when you or your family is hungry. The SHOP (Supplies Helping Our Peers) meets the food, hygiene, and basic needs of our students and colleagues as our community's food pantry. Each month, SHOP volunteers work with community resources and partners to make \$300 cover the need presented by students and staff. Your help could fund the The SHOP for an entire semester.

Stand in the Gap Package Item #5 \$1,000

Every once in a while, a student will meet a financial circumstance when it seems like the only option is to quit school. This package makes perseverance possible. Bundle a textbook voucher, SHOP supplies, and a donation to our student emergency fund so students can pay that unexpected bill, be classroom ready, and take home food for their family.

According to a recent study by The Hope Center at Temple University, nearly 1 in 4 students at community colleges experience food insecurity. This is a higher percentage than students at 4-year or graduate institutions. To date, The SHOP, Rhodes State's Food Pantry, has served over 211 student families with over 8,400 pounds of food plus \$9,900 in transportation assistance.

Did you know that Rhodes State College educates and prepares students as young as 2nd grade? Through our children and youth programs and camps, we can kindle a fire for a bright future in the hearts of our region's future workforce and scholars. 
